



Club Vote on Revised By-laws

Every five years the club is required by Kiwanis International (KI) to review and approve the clubs bylaws and policies. This year there has been work done to revise our by-laws before the September 30th deadline set by KI. It is required that the club adopt the by-laws that were presented by KI. Nothing in these by-laws is new but many things in the current by-laws have been eliminated to allow clubs to be more flexible. There are six mandatory policies that must be addressed. These include Dues and Fees, Members in Good Standing, Officers and Directors, Officers and Directors Terms, Officer and Directors Election Process and Annual Financial Review. The board will be keeping these as close to current practice as possible.

There are also six other policy areas that are optional. The following policies are being addressed: Club Meeting Information, Standing Committees, Special Membership Types and Special Voting Requirements.

At the discussion of these at the board level it was decided to entertain a policy on Special Voting Requirements that covers multi-year funding requests. This will be discussed at the September 16th board meeting.

The club membership will vote on the by-law and policy recommendation approved and passed by the board at the September 18th club meeting. More complete information will be presented to the membership before the September 18th vote.
