Kiwanis Coats for Kids

This Kiwanis project provides new coats to needy children from new born to 5 years old. We are currently working with the Nest and Head Start to establish the list of coats needed. With it being cold earlier this year, in mid-November we delivered 68 new coats. If additional need is determined we will purchase more coats all winter long. The project started in 1991 and was awarded the Iowa "Governor's Award".



This project has two facets:

Purchasing and giving away the coats.

First we need to identify the need by gender, quantity, and what sizes the child wears. Coordination of the sizes needed is a challenge when it comes the purchasing of the coats. We try not to purchase all the same color and style for the same size. You want to avoid the identification that a group of kids all got the same coat from Kiwanis. This year the coats came from ShopKo, Target, JCPenney.com, and BurlingtonCoatFactory.com.

Funding is the second Facet of the project.

- Kiwanis members always help with donations during a weekly meeting. This year it will be December 3rd and members have been great to support the project over the years.
- The goal has always been to fund this project completely therefore Corporate donations have provided the additional funding needed;
 - o Winegard has been a long term supporter and this year gave \$1,000.
 - o The ShopKo Foundation provided \$500.
