
Pancake Breakfast Wrap Up

Thanks to all who sold tickets, bought a hog plus contributed hours of effort to another very successful pancake breakfast and a record setting year for our 27th Annual Pancake Breakfast. George & Dennis, Co-Chairman

- 1. 141 Volunteers (including family & friends) for 545 Volunteer Hours.
- 2. 2669 served which was 200 lower than last year.
- 3. Ticket sales at door was up almost \$500 over last year.
- 4. Advance ticket sales were slightly less than last year (we lost \$500 in sales from one of our major ticket sellers)
- 5. Hog Sales were slightly less than last year.
- 6. Our 1st year sponsorship program produced \$2650 in additional revenue.
- 7. We lowered our expenses by 3% (thanks to Hy-Vee, GRMC & Walmart).
- 8. Our bottom line was up 7% from last year.
- 9. Our net revenue raised was \$29K which was \$2K more than last year.
- 10. 2015 was a record year in that only 2009 & 2010 had better results.
