Another Pancake Breakfast is in the Books

The 2016 Burlington Kiwanis Pancake Breakfast started out a little shaky with lots of rain the night before and then strong winds in the early morning hours. But thanks to Larry Turley's prayer on the Thursday before, the sky's cleared and it became a beautiful day to serve the community that we all live in.

We had 145 people volunteer and 570 hours during the event. We had 81 of the Kiwanis members volunteering their time for set-up, cooking, and tear down.

As of right now we are sitting at \$28,787.76 for net income, which is down 2.93% over 2015, but we are still missing some of the other sponsorship monies along with 26 people still to turn in their tickets. Once everything gets turned in we should be really close to \$30,000 net income for the 2016 event.

volunteered your time, sold tickets, donated to the hog fund, bought left over sausage, ate, and just helped keep 2016 a great year for the Kiwanis Pancake Breakfast.
