The Pancake Breakfast is always wonderful and helps make it another great year in our fund-raising efforts.

As of July 13th, total deposits were \$35,407. This amount is comprised of \$24,521 in ticket sales, \$7,680 in sponsorships and \$3,206 in hog and sausage donations.

There are still about 20 ticket packets that aren't in this total, so there may be additional tickets sold. In addition, there was another \$2, 345 in sponsorships and hog/ sausage sales not yet received.
