My Fellow Kiwanians

First a little business. As I announced at our meeting on February 22nd, we have two multi-year pledges that the membership will vote on at our March 8th lunch meeting. We will have some additional information and discussion on our March 1st and 8th meetings prior to the votes.

Motion #1 is regarding the Dankwardt Pool Bubble. Representatives of this project presented to our club last October during the infancy of their campaign. At the time funding was not awarded. However, they have clarified a few topics and once again approached Kiwanis to assist in funding the pool bubble which will provide additional and full lane size swimming opportunities for area youth. As of my writing the motion is to approve a 5-year commitment at \$1,000 per year, for a total of \$5,000 towards the project.

Motion #2 is regarding Bridges out of Poverty. As you may recall, Kiwanis supported this program during it's initial phases with a \$20,000 one-time pledge in the 2015/16 year. After seeing some great success and understanding the dynamics of the program and what efforts need to be maintained to ensure future success of the program and the families impacted by it, they have put forward a \$90,000 annual budget. Part of the original discussion was to help fund the start-up and then re-evaluate after some classes had been completed. No funding was given in the 2016/17 Kiwanis year and we now have a sample of "getting ahead" and "staying ahead" attendees and the impact Bridges is having in the betterment of their life path and that of their families and children. While the classes are largely focused on the adults, there is a child component as day care and other activities are provided for children while the classes are in session. As of my writing the motion is to approve a 3-year commitment at \$20,000 per year, for a total of \$60,000 towards Bridges out of Poverty.

I can tell you that neither of these motions were entered lightly by your board. I am pleased and blessed to have a strong group of our peers reviewing our funding requests and asking appropriate questions. Our mission as a club, and the long term financial health is ever present in the conversation. I think they have done a tremendous job of representing our club. On behalf of our board, I ask that you please make an effort to attend March 8th and vote on the two motions above. Thank you!

It is strange not having the Shamrock Shuffle the lead in the March newsletter. This year marks the earliest date (March 10th) that the 5K fun color run will be held. It is always the Saturday before St. Patrick's Day. The committee has once again done an excellent job in preparation and making a few small twists and tweaks to keep the experience new and exciting for participants. At this point, sponsorship money is in and all that is left is to plea for great weather and VOLUNTEERS! Please consider volunteering, you can find more information on page 2. I look forward to seeing your smiling faces. Registrations remain strong again this year and this event provides an excellent opportunity to share the power that is our Kiwanis club on 1,000 folks!
