## Board of Directors Update

Your Directors and Officers approved the following funding requests at the last board meeting.

Aid to the Needy, which is also known as the Nurses Program where area School Nurses can purchase items immediately for children in need, used \$860.76 in December.

Burlington Public Library requested funds for a Stork's Story time Reading Program. This initiative targets expecting families to develop good reading habits before the baby arrives. The program was funded at \$500.

Lend A Paw Pantry, in conjunction with the backpack program, provides food to families in need. There are currently 344 children enrolled in the backpack program. The program was funded at\$3,000

Iowa Vocational Services requested funds for a Summer Career Boot Camp for 30 students, in four counties. With the partnership of the Homestead 1839, the focus is to participate in career based activities and explore occupations. The Board approved \$250 to assist the program.
