Coats for Kids

This is our 29th year of providing coats for kids in need. The project provides new coats to needy children from newborn to 5 years old. For many years we have worked with The Nest and Head Start. This year we added the Burlington Area YMCA with two of their program's needs, the YMCA Child Care Center and the Kiddie Campus at SCC.



These organizations identify the gender and the size of coats needed. Coordination of the sizes needed is a challenge when it comes to purchasing the coats. We try not to purchase all the same color and style for the same size coat. You want to avoid the identification that a group of kids all got the same coat from Kiwanis. Supply chain issues as well as the changing needs have been a challenge this year, resulting in multiple trips to Target (West Burlington and Davenport) and Kohls. This year so far, we have supplied 66 heavyweight winter coats. We have in the past had additional requests for coats as the temperature drops. We will fill the additional needs as they are identified all winter.
