Your Directors and Officers have continued to meet and have approved the following funding requests at the last board meeting.

The following are services and programs of the Kiwanis Club:

The Aid to the Needy, the program that allows school nurses to purchase items for students, supported \$53.50 in December.

Outside Organization Funding Requests:

The Nest of Des Moines County was awarded \$3,000 to provide food, health and safety items for children and their families. The Nest is an accredited, not-for-profit that provides weekly research based parenting classes.

The annual donation of \$1,000 to the Salvation Army was approved.

Bridges Out of Poverty, our final payment of \$20,000 was approved.

We will continue our book donations to the Burlington Public Library for out weekly speakers. The cost is \$480 annually.
