Outstanding Results for the Pancake Sponsor Drive

43 Members (34% of our total) recruited 62 sponsorships this year for a total of \$16,500 which is 155% of the total we raised in 2019 (\$10,650) and 365% of what we raised our first year for financial sponsors (\$3,550) in 2015. One member recruited 10 sponsorships, one member recruited 8, and one member recruited 5 resulting in over one third of all the total sponsorships. We had four sponsors who increased their level this year from 2019 and we had 29 new sponsors who joined our effort.

Thanks to all who made this a banner year! With this kind of commitment from our members, I'm confident we can surpass \$20,000 next year.
