## Board Report

Aid to the Needy: For February was \$691.54

Iowa Vocational Rehabilitation Services was awarded \$150 for their Summer Career Boot Camp Program. Southeastern Iowa High School students, ages 14-21 years old, will participate in free career based activities such as: engage in virtual presentations, tours, volunteer, and interactive activities to learn essential work skills

Camp Courageous was approved \$750 to sponsor a Des Moines County child, in part or in whole, to attend their Summer Camp for disabled children

Burlington Fire Department will receive \$150 for their Fire Safety Educational Program. These funds will be used to purchase and distribute fire prevention material, to area children

Big Hollow's Outdoor Youth Jamboree will provide a free, one day, family-fun outdoor event with the board approved funding of \$500. They serve children in the surrounding counties 2-18 years of age

The Burlington Kiwanis will once again sponsor an area Little League Youth Team, with a sponsorship of \$350

Burlington Police Department was granted \$150 for the purchase of Safety Educational Material, for area children aged preschool and up.
