

Dear Fellow Kiwanians:

Your Board of Directors has discussed on many occasions and contemplated the various options in relation to the Project Eliminate issues. I want to thank all of the Board members and Officers as well as all of the members that have had input on this issue as it has not been an easy issue to complete.

It was not difficult for all involved to get to the point of deciding that something needed to be provided. The question was how much and how should that be taken to the membership for final vote. Your Board of Directors has unanimously voted to present to the Club a commitment to the Project Eliminate in the amount of \$50,000.00, which would be \$10,000.00 per year. The matter will be presented to the Club as a whole with a vote of the members that are present at the club meeting on July 17, 2014. The Board considered all the various issues and there was a great deal of discussion as to alternatives. The Project Eliminate Committee will have a presentation at the meeting on the 17th and then we will move towards a vote of the members. The vote is required due to the fact that the commitment on this matter extends beyond the present fiscal year.

Separately, there will be presented opportunities for individuals to give to the Project Eliminate including those individuals that may choose to commit to a level that would garner a Zeller Award. All that will be discussed in further detail, but that is separate from the Club's commitment.

I believe your Board did a fantastic job of trying to work through some very difficult issues and come to a unanimous decision. Please speak with any of the Board members or Officers as to any questions or issues that you might have in relation to this matter and be prepared to discuss the same at our meeting on the 17th.

A huge thank you again to all of the volunteers that participated in the annual pancake breakfast. A reminder also that if you are looking at your calendars, there was to be no noon meeting on August 7. Bees night has now been moved to August 14.
